

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

THE TABLE GUY UK

- Lay the tabletop on a floor on a cloth so it doesn't get damaged.
- Carefully remove a wooden batten at one end, leave the others attached (if supplied).
- Carefully unwrap the metal legs. Please note they may be labelled A or B (or 1 & 2).
- The arrow on the legs (handwritten on tape) points into the middle of the table (if applicable).
- Lightly hand screw each of the black screws (only a couple of turns), repeat for all holes. You may need to squeeze or separate the boards, and or tilt the leg, so that the holes line up enough for the screws. Please note: It may be necessary to loosen all screws on any attached plates.
- All holes are drilled using a jig, so if the holes are not alligning, please try again, remembering to loosen all screws, before the 2nd attempt.
- When all the screws are lightly in, screw in tightly. Be careful not to tighten too much as you'll round of the screw head.
- Repeat for the other end.
- Lastly, turn your table upright and begin enjoying!
